Biography of Phillip Yin

Phillip Yin was previously a television anchor and reporter in Hong Kong covering economic and market developments. Phillip has interviewed numerous economists, politicians, and industry leaders to help viewers understand global events and how it affects them. His interviews include International Monetary Fund Managing Director Christine Lagarde, The World Bank President Robert Zoellick, Standard and Poor's President Deven Sharma, HSBC Bank CEO Peter Wong, East West Bank CEO Dominic Ng, and tennis champion Roger Federer.

Previously, Yin served as strategy advisor at Unifund, Yin has also served the U.S. based Charles Schwab to help build business and to help clients on retirement planning. Prior to that, he served as the anchor/correspondent for CNBC Television.

Phillip was raised in Eastern Washington for 18 years and to attend University in Seattle. He worked for financial firms and served CIBC Oppenheimer as an advisor and spokesperson. In addition, in Seattle's Q13 Fox News, he was the economics and business correspondent helping cover the events following 9/11 attacks in New York City and Washington D.C.

Phillip Yin received an International MBA from Georgetown University in Washington D.C. and an undergraduate Business degree from the University of Washington. He was awarded and attended a minority summer program at Harvard University. He also previously served on the Citizen's Oversight Council for Washington Transportation's Sound Transit. This position is appointed by the Mayor of Seattle and also by senior State Transportation officials. He and his wife Michelle continue to be avid supporters of various charities and non-profit organizations. They have two daughters, Kelsey (13), and their recent newborn Katie and reside in the Seattle area.
